**Atlanta Restoration Professional to be Featured on National Radio Show**

From this extensive study, Mr. McLaughlin determined that following the New York City guidelines, EPA recommendations, and OSHA suggestions for handling small amounts of mold (less than 10 ft.<sup>2</sup>) can put people at significant risk because the right engineering controls and protections aren't being used. Mr. McLaughlin will be discussing his startling discoveries on IAQ RADIO.

The show's hosts are Joe Hughes, President of IAQ Training Institute and Cliff Zlotnik, President Emeritus of Microban Systems.
